MLK, Jr. Events in Hayward/Castro Valley: On Sunday, **Jan 14**, the Castro Valley Community Alliance will show the film *A Time for Justice: America's Civil Rights Movement*, followed by a panel and community discussion. 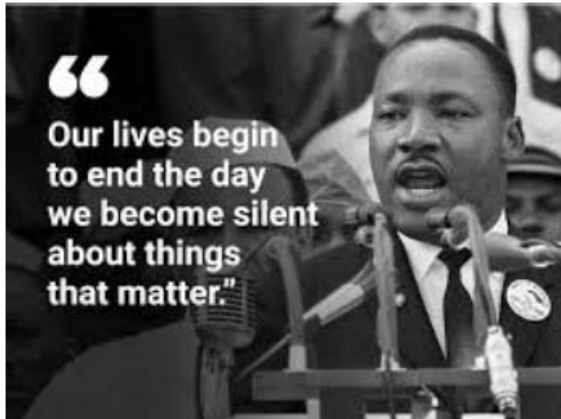
